Sunday School at CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH

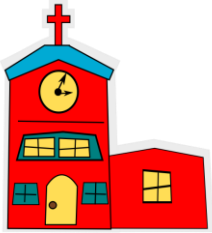
We are so happy to announce the return of Sunday School at Christ Church starting **September 17th!!**
